Course Selection

- You are not required to make any course selections.
- All candidates admitted to the first year Medical Radiation Sciences Program will be enrolled in the required curriculum set by the Program.

Fee Payment

- **Fees must be paid at a bank before September 6, 2011.**

Registration

- No official registration forms need to be completed or signed.
- Your signed offer of acceptance to the Medical Radiation Sciences Program is the official documentation required
- **Registration is activated by payment of fees.**

ROSI (Repository of Student Information)

- ROSI is the student record system for the University of Toronto.
- Visit Student Web Service <http://www.rosi.utoronto.ca/> for ROSI access
- **It is your responsibility to update your current address and phone number**
- If you are new to UofT, the personal data currently entered in ROSI was taken from the information provided by OUAC (Ontario Universities' Application Centre)
- During academic session, all correspondence mailed by the University of Toronto will be sent to your mailing address. Please ensure that this information is updated **no later than September 16, 2011.**
- ROSI Access
 - Enter your student number, followed by your PIN number.
 - For students accessing ROSI for the first time your PIN number will be your date of birth. ROSI will then ask you to select a personal six-digit PIN number and verify it. This must consist of numbers **NOT** letters. Please select a number that is easy to remember.
 - Once your PIN number has been established, ROSI will no longer accept your date of birth.
