# **FULL APPLICATION**

## Submission Deadline: Friday August 28, 2020, 5PM EST (INVITATION ONLY)

Successful applicants will be invited to submit a full application. The following are components of the full application, some will require additional preparation and time so it is advisable to begin preparing some of this during the LOI stage.

- 1. 3 Referee Letters (submitted directly to the program manager)
- 2. Official transcripts of the applicant's academic record (undergraduate and graduate degrees) (translated documents are required if not in English)
- 3. Research Proposal (2 pages)
- 4. Statement of Interest (1 page)
